

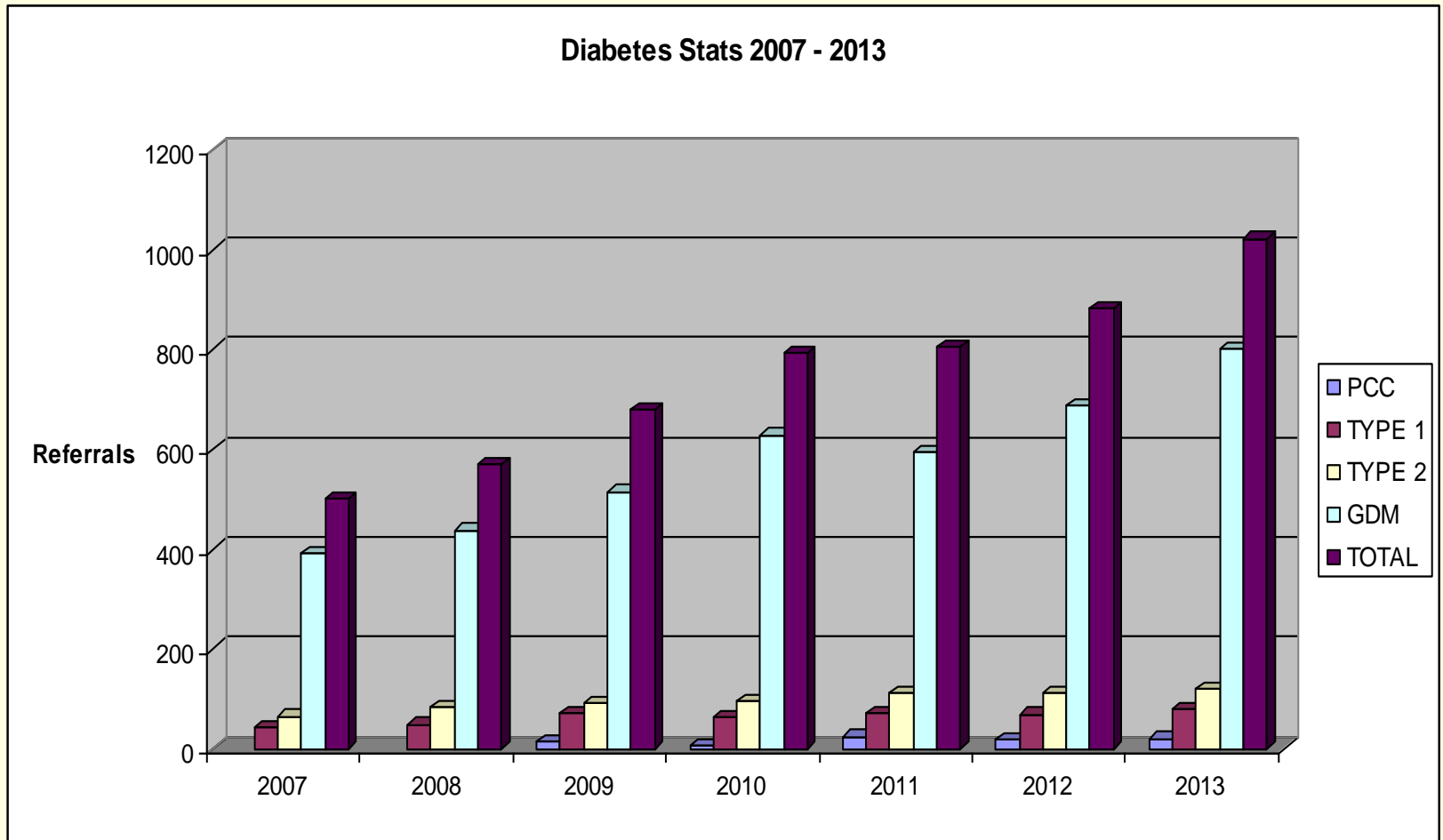

What do we do?

Gestational Diabetes – group education class

- One large English speaking class + one interpreter class is offered each week.
- Each class runs for 2 hours
- Dietitian and diabetes educator facilitate
- Education reinforced at antenatal clinic visits

Type 1 & type 2 education programs

- Preconception or early pregnancy education sessions
- Usually individual but may be a small class
- Diabetes educator and dietitian facilitate
- Education reinforced at subsequent clinic visits

What else do we do?

- Insulin pump education/carb counting/ adjustment of doses
- Continuous glucose monitoring systems
- Commencing insulin sessions (type 2 & GDM women)
- Ambulatory stabilisation for women on diabetes medications
- Inpatient review – Antenatal, Postnatal, Gynaecology/Oncology
- Telehealth for women in rural and remote communities
- Women's Health Outreach service x 4 times year
- Diabetes team antenatal clinics x 2 week
- Nurse Practitioner led midwife GDM clinic x 1 week
- Lectures/ workshops/ study days - hospital staff internal & external, under & post graduate midwifery students/refresher midwives.
- Precept various students on clinical placement
- Provide NDSS supplies
